

Please read *carefully* before filling out your application:

1. All communication regarding the Institute will be done via email, all orchestra and chamber music will be set via email. **Please add japansSeattle@hotmail.com to your contacts list.** If you do not receive an email notifying you that your registration has been received and your orchestra music attached within 10 days of your application FIRST check your junk mail, then email me and I will reply.
2. All persons staying in the dorm MUST buy a full meal package. There are no exceptions to this rule for food allergies. Every child under the age of 12 who is eating a meal in the cafeteria MUST be accompanied by an adult, who has also purchased a meal. This is a Seattle Pacific University policy and they cannot change it.
3. There are no family apartments this year. Emerson Hall is actually much nicer than the apartments, and we have access to rooms that sleep up to 4, for the same price as a double room. You can also request to have a family share two rooms that are adjoined by a bathroom for the price of 2 double rooms, just make a note of that on the bottom of your registration sheet.
4. There are NO extra meals or lodging other than what is specified on the registration sheet. SPU has groups before and after our Institute so they are unable to accommodate special requests.
5. Advanced students willing to play viola in the orchestra and/or chamber group for a \$50 scholarship. Please note that scholarship on your sheet and adjust your amount owed accordingly. There are a limited number of violas available to borrow for the Institute. Please contact Holly at japansSeattle@hotmail.com for more information
6. Recordings for Lewis/Barston auditions: you may send in piece OTHER than what you wish to play for your masterclass, however, you must inform me of a change of piece prior to June 1 to allow our accompanists time to rehearse.
7. Honors Recital Applicants: You MUST send in a recording of the piece you plan on performing. You may NOT change the piece you wish to play.
8. Both Honors Recital and Lewis/Barston applicants: please send me a COPY of your accompaniment, DO NOT SEND THE ORIGINAL, you should always keep your original with you when giving music out, please bring your original with you just in case something should happen to the copy of your accompaniment.
9. Chamber Music applicants: please note that this year we are requesting an audition tape, email japansSeattle@hotmail.com for the music that you should send us a video of you performing. This will help us create groups that are as enjoyable as possible.
10. Scheduling: I cannot provide any greater detail as to your individual schedule prior to the first day of the Institute. Please read the website carefully regarding the hours that your child will be expected to be on campus.
11. SPU is an open campus. For safety reasons ALL CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 12 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES. No exceptions.
