- Rhythm** (for children 5 years and younger, who are not yet ready for Music Reading and Orchestra)
- Music Reading and Musicianship** (for children in any book, 5 years and older, who need to work on beginning music reading skills - much, if not all, of the activities will be without an instrument)
- Debut Orchestra** (A first experience for children in any book who know the notes in first position and easy rhythms. One piece of music will be sent in advance, there will also be easy music distributed and sight read during class.)
- Beginning Orchestra** (children in Books 2 and 3 who can read fluently in first position, various rhythms)
- Intermediate Orchestra** (only for children in Book 4 and above, Book 6 and above students may choose this option)
- Advanced Orchestra** (strictly limited to those in Book 6 and above)
